The ability to use language effectively lies at the centre of thinking and learning. In National 5 French candidates reflect, communicate and develop ideas through language. The course provides candidates with the opportunity to develop skills in reading, listening, talking and writing, which are essential for learning, for work and for life and to develop understanding of how language works.
