

Course: Art and Design

Course Outline

Pupils are required to successfully complete 2 unit assessments as follows:

• **Practical folio Activity**— Learners will carry out practical activities building a portfolio of either expressive art or design work on a single theme. They will work in a range of materials to demonstrate a breadth of skills.

Level: Advanced Higher

Art and Design Studies – Learners will undertake the study of an artists or a couple of related artists or
designers where there is a link to the students work. They will demonstrate in depth knowledge and
understanding of specific works. Learners will develop their analytical and evaluative skills and be able
to use these to respond to personally selected pieces of fine art or design and link these to their folios.

External course assessment consists of two parts:

- A formal written dissertation marked externally by the SQA. 30 marks
- The submission of either a Design or Expressive folios of work for external assessment by the SQA. 60 marks
- Written evaluation of practical folio 10 marks.

To improve on his current performance with **Advanced Higher Art and Design** your child could use some of the following strategies:-

Strategy	✓
Produce a study planner to ensure regular study each week	
Revise course notes	
Summarise course notes and highlight essential points or information	
Make use of spider diagrams, flow diagrams or other study aids to help organise key pieces of	
information	
Complete all homework tasks set and on time	
Attend supported study classes on offer.	
Use appropriate terminology associated with the subject	
Inform the teacher of areas of work that are proving problematic	
Use non-contact periods to work with peers to share ideas and complete tasks	
Ensure deadlines are met for different areas in projects	
Manage time to ensure all written work can be completed and marked by the teacher before	
submission to SQA	
Apply more effort in class to ensure all work is complete	
Plan time and be active in taking responsibility for the presenting and mounting up of work	
Ensure practical work is completed in good time to be mounted and presented	
Keep all work completed safe and in good order for portfolio submissions	
Organise materials to ensure that practical work can be done at home
