2 of the following 3 units must be completed:

- **Geography:** Physical Environments
- **Historical Study:** Scottish Unit
- **Modern Studies:** Social Issues

There is no external assessment for this Course.

- Learners must successfully complete four units to achieve the full Course Award.
- All Units are internally assessed on a pass/fail basis. A portfolio of evidence is built up throughout the Course and will be externally verified by the SQA.

To improve on his current performance with **National Scottish Studies** your child could use some of the following strategies:-

Produce a study planner to ensure regular study each week	
Revise course notes regularly to keep on top of content	
Make use of spider diagrams, cue cards or other study aids to help organise key pieces of information	
Complete all homework tasks set and on hand in on time

Ensure deadlines are met for SQA assignments and projects	
Identify command words at the start of questions to ensure questions are answered properly	
Apply more effort in class to ensure all work is complete

Extend the level of detail and exemplification in written work	
Prepare thoroughly for class assessments and act on any feedback provided by class teachers

Complete all sections of Travel and Tourism folio work	
Complete all sections of History unit assessment	
Complete all sections of Modern Studies unit assessment
