Online Learning

During school closures, pupils will be able to follow their normal school timetable. During periods when pupils would have each subject, teachers will be online to support learning. They may do so in the following ways,:

- Delivering online, interactive lessons (audio, visual or screen sharing)
- Setting tasks (via Teams or Satchel One)
- Communicating with pupils via the chat function on Teams

In most cases, young people will be invited to join a Teams meeting with their teacher. Attendance and engagement will be monitored so during Teams meetings attendance will be taken. PTs may be in touch if they notice learners are not engaging to assess whether there are any problems with access.

Online Learning Platforms and Apps

To access home learning, pupils will need to access the following. They will use their glow email and password to log in to these.:


- Microsoft Teams – enables learners to access to class resources, engage in class discussions and access online lessons. This is not supported on Safari so pupils need to download the app on to their school iPad.
- Satchel One – allows learners and families to view work set or details of upcoming tasks/lessons/homework
- Glow – allows pupils to access their emails and access Satchel One if the app is not working
- Microsoft OneNote – some teachers may use this as a digital jotter which allows pupils to show their learning and for teachers to provide feedback.

Some Advice – Usernames and Passwords

Learners are the only people who should have access to the iPad so it may be a good idea to suggest to your young person that they save their glow details and details of their school computer log in to their notes.

Pupils will need to use their school computer log in and password if the Proxy Authentication message appears on their screen. They should click Settings and this will prompt them to enter these details.

How Can You Help Us Support Your Young Person?

- · Ensure your child is up and ready to learn at the usual start time.
- · Provide a suitable place for working. They will need their iPad and space to write.
- · Monitor what learning is to be done by checking Satchel One (if you don't have the app you can see this on our school website).
- · Make sure your child charges their iPad daily and that they are able to access Glow, Satchel One and Teams.
- · Encourage your child to interact in lessons with their teachers and to ask their teachers if they need help. They can do this through Teams or email.
- · Keep in touch with the school and let us know as soon as possible of any difficulties. We are here to help.
