Welcome back to school! We are so glad we can re-open and help you start learning and achieving again. Many things about school will be the same as before but some things will be very different.

This guide tells you about the key changes that have been made to keep everyone safe while at school.

Our Values and Expectations

Be ambitious: work hard and aim high to achieve the best possible outcomes.

Times of the School Day

These have changed slightly. Do not come to school before the time indicated here, either in the morning or after lunch. We need to keep different year groups separate from each other.

S1 -3 move on the first bell. S4 -6 move on the second bell at period1, Lunch and end of day.

Arriving at School

Different year groups now need to enter by different gates and doors.

S1 and **S4** pupils enter by the back gates in Old Wood Road or the gate beside Ladyhill Drive and assemble in the playground behind Modern Languages.

This is your allocated playground and is the only outdoor space you can use.

S2 and **S6** pupils enter by the main gates on Glasgow Road and enter school through the gates at front of the school (as you did before) and assemble in the internal playgrounds. This is your allocated playground and the only outdoor space you can use.

S3 and **S5** pupils enter by the gates on Huntingtower Road and assemble in the playground behind Music and Drama. This is your allocated playground and the only outdoor space you can use.

Keeping Everyone Safe

You must take responsibility for keeping yourself and others safe.

Do not come to school if you display any symptoms of Covid-19.

The most common symptoms are:

New, continuous cough

Fever/high temperature

Loss of, or change in, sense of smell or taste.

If you develop these symptoms when in school, tell your teacher straightaway and we will look after you in our quarantine room while waiting for your parent/ carer to collect you.

Hand Hygiene

You must wash your hands or use hand sanitiser:

- Whenever you come into school
- When moving to a new location
- After eating
- When you leave the building

Physical Distancing

Pupils in school do not need to maintain a 1 or 2 metre distance from each other, but you should avoid close physical contact with your friends (e.g. no hugs, handshakes, etc).

You should not share personal belongings e.g phones, stationery, water bottles, food, with others in school.

You must stay **2 metres** from **all adults** in the school at all times. This includes in corridors, classrooms, outdoors spaces and the fuelzone.

Corridors

- There is a one-way system in place which **must** be followed. There is a map of this at the end of this guide.
- You should keep apart as much as possible in corridors and a 2 metre distance with adults must be maintained.
- Some corridors and stairs are now restricted for the use of particular year groups.
- You must use outside routes to classrooms whenever possible and staff will instruct you to do so.
- These new routes may mean you take longer to get to class and will be used even when it is raining.
- You will always be outside for interval and lunch – come prepared for all weathers!

Classrooms

- You must sit in the desk allocated by your teacher.
- Remember your teacher cannot be less than 2metres from you. This means they may not be able to move around the classroom in the way you are used to.
- You must wash or sanitise your hands when you come into the classroom.
- You are responsible for wiping down your desk when you leave the class.
- S1 and S2 only will be in one classroom for all their learning for the first few weeks of term.
- We no longer have our S6 study room. S6 will sign out of school during private study periods.

Behaving responsibly

You **must** follow our Bannerman Behaviour Blueprint. You are expected to behave respectfully and responsibly at all times.

This means following all instructions. They are designed to keep you safe and make sure that the school can stay open.

Digital Learning

You will need to know your Glow Login and how to get into Glow, Teams, Satchel One and email. Your teachers will check you can do this on day one and will help you whenever you need.

Equipment

You must bring all the equipment you need for school every day.

This includes:

- stationery items (pencil, pen, rubber, sharpener, ruler, and highlighters)
- any books, folders or jotters
- PE kit
- a calculator for Maths, or any other special items you need for subjects.

We can give you stationery on the first day of term if you don't have them, but you won't be able to borrow things in class.

Lunchtime

The Fuelzone will be offering breakfast, interval and lunch from the 17th August.

If you have Free School Meals, then you can continue to collect your meals and snack as usual.

You can no longer pay cash in the Fuelzone. Your parents can pay for snacks and lunch in advance only.

You can eat a packed lunch in school or, from S2 upwards, go home or to local shops at lunchtime.

If you leave school for lunch, you must behave responsibly in the local community. You must wear a facemask in all shops and takeaways, stay 2m apart from everyone else, follow the rules about how many people can enter at a time and **put all your litter in the bin.**

Cleaning and litter

We have extra cleaning in the school to protect everyone from Covid-19. The staff involved in this will have less time to do other tasks such as litter picks so **you** need to take extra responsibility to make sure all litter goes in a bin.

You will also need to wipe down your desk / equipment after you leave class.

Uniform

School uniform must be worn at all times.

You will be able to change into PE kit in school. We had introduced PE Hoodies as an item of clothing in our earlier planning. If you have already purchased one, you can wear this to school as part of your uniform. Only Bannerman hoodies are allowed.

If you need help with uniform, speak to your Pastoral Care Teacher.




