Dear Parent/Carer

S6 National Qualifications 2023

Your child is now in the final stage of their coursework and preparation for their 2023 National Qualifications. It is extremely important that both you and your child are familiar with the date(s) and time(s) of the examinations, which they are due to sit during the exam diet. Pupils should ensure that for each exam they check the notices at the front office to ensure that they have the correct location.

We would also request that pupils arrive with plenty of time to sit each examination and be ready outside the exam room at least 10 minutes before the exam is due to start. If for any reason they are late, they must report to a member of the Senior Leadership Team who will decide if your child can sit the exam. If your child is unable to sit an exam because of illness or any other reason, this must be reported as soon as possible to the school.

Your child has also been issued with a “**Your Exams 2023**” booklet and this gives further important information in relation to the SQA examinations -

The guidelines have been issued to all schools by the SQA and must be adhered to. In particular, it lists the items that are prohibited in the examination room:-

- Mobile Phone
- Electronic Devices that are web enabled such as Smartwatch/Tablet
- Book/Notes/Sketches or paper
- Pencil Case/Calculator Case

This is in compliance with SQA guidelines and under **no** circumstances should they be taken into the examination room. If a pupil fails to follow our instructions regarding mobile phones she/he will have the phone confiscated but this will be at the owner’s risk. If a mobile phone should ring during an exam there is a strong possibility that the pupil will forfeit the exam. This complies with SQA guidelines. Should they need to, candidates can access a telephone in the school office if they require to contact a member of their family following their examination.

Candidates should also liaise with their Maths teacher regarding the use of calculators in the examination room. Again, any candidate found in possession of an unauthorised calculator will have their examination paper withdrawn.

Please note study arrangements below, which are to ensure S6 learners have maximum opportunity for exam study, support from teachers and consolidation of coursework, in preparation for their examinations and post-school options:

- From close of school on **Friday 21st April 2023**, S6 pupils will be on study leave.
- It may be that your child wishes to consult with members of staff during the period of Study Leave to answer any particular problems, which have arisen during revision. Pupils are welcome to attend for such help at the normal timetabled periods for each subject, when teachers should be available for consultation. Timetabled masterclasses will also take place prior to each exam.
- Please note there are school holidays on **Monday 1st May** and **8th May**. There are no exams these days and the school will be closed. However, on the Inservice **Thursday 25th May 2023** and school holiday dates **Friday 26th May** and **Monday 29th May**, there are exams taking place. Pupils must attend, in full school uniform, for examinations timetabled on those days.

S6 students have been excellent supporters of our school uniform policy and I would ask you to remind your child that uniform must be worn **whenever** pupils come into school.

As S6 pupils have now reached the end of their school career, all pupils should return their iPad and charger by the end of May 2023, unless otherwise agreed.

To ensure the smooth running of exams school staff and invigilators will also be present during the examinations. Should you have any queries regarding any SQA examination matters please do not hesitate to contact myself or your child's Pupil Support Teacher/Year Head for clarification.
